Manuel Jiménez Ramírez: Animal Sculptures: Painting

List of Required Supplies: Acrylic or tempera paints in multiple colors (black and white are required), paint brushes, cup for water, rags or paper towels, paint palette (paper plates work great), paint brushes: large and small. Optional: Q-Tips for paint dotting, tablecloth/newspaper for keeping table clean.

Space/Facility Requirements: Surface for painting on, chair, access to water

Student Time Required: Full time period

Step-by-step Instructions:

- 1. Create a paint palette with the colors you want to use.
- Paint your animal with a base coat of whatever colors you want. Don't make the paint too thick.
- 3. Make sure you have black and white paints and a small brush.
- 4. Use the paint to create texture by covering the animals with small, dotted lines.
- Tip: Younger students can use Q-Tips for the dotting technique.
