## Manuel Jiménez Ramírez: Animal Sculptures: Painting

List of Required Supplies: Acrylic or tempera paints in multiple colors (black and white are required), paint brushes, cup for water, rags or paper towels, paint palette (paper plates work great), paint brushes: large and small. Optional: Q-Tips for paint dotting, tablecloth/newspaper for keeping table clean.

Space/Facility Requirements: Surface for painting on, chair, access to water

Student Time Required: Full time period

## Step-by-step Instructions:

1. Create a paint palette with the colors you want to use.
2. Paint your animal with a base coat of whatever colors you want. Don't make the paint too thick.
3. Make sure you have black and white paints and a small brush.
4. Use the paint to create texture by
covering the animals with small,
5. Use the paint to create texture by
covering the animals with small, dotted lines.
6. Tip: Younger students can use Q-Tips for the dotting technique.
