These are principles that were established by Disney animators Frank Thomas and Ollie Johnston, and are published in their book "Illusion of Life." They are principles that all animators use to guide their animation.

They were written with drawn animation in mind, but the basic concepts apply to all forms of animation. Give them a read, and apply them as your understanding allows. The more you animate, the more they will make sense. Don't worry if they don't make sense at first!

Apply these as best you can as complete the rest of your animation.

Remember, this is your first film! You can continue to make many more, and you can also just practice animating when you are done.
